Week 2 Report on Community Project

We have now collected 1,022 masks, 147 scrub caps, 6 pair surgery shoe covers and 54 hospital gowns in just 2 weeks! This is a project of the Lincoln Quilters Guild, Lincoln Modern Quilt Guild and many generous friends! We couldn't do it without everyone's help! Masks and hospital gowns are now our top need.

The masks have been delivered to Bryan Health, Lancaster County Sheriffs, Lincoln Lancaster Mental Health Crisis Center, Lancaster County Detention, Tabitha Healthcare, St. Elizabeth's Hospital, Home Health Care, Mandarin Independence House, Czech Village, Freedom Health Care, and Barnabas Community. We plan to provide masks for the Peoples City Mission (adult and child sizes) and more for St. Elizabeth Hospital and Home Health Care. The requests keep pouring in!

Scrub caps, surgery shoe covers and masks are for Bryan Health.

Hospital gowns and masks are for Tabitha Healthcare. The gowns are for staff caring for residents. Many more are wanted. We do have fabric if you would like to make them.

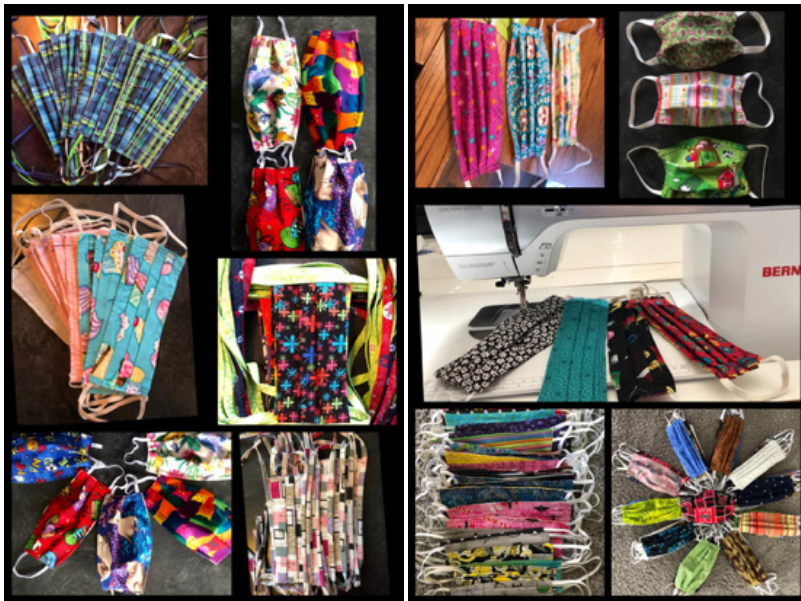
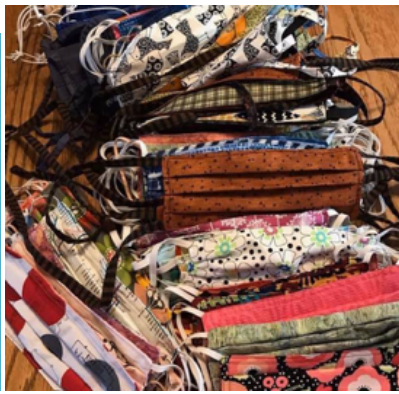
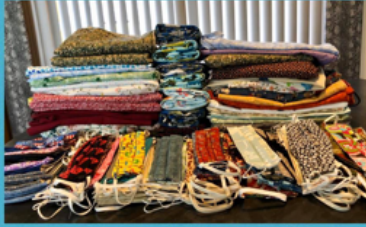
