Monday's meeting of the Lincoln Quilters Guild (April 10) will once again be packed with activity! In fact, we have so many things planned that you will want to arrive early to take advantage. Fabric will be sold for \$2 per pound (half price compared to the Isles sale) and books will be 50 cents each or 3 for \$1. Cash or checks only, please. Also, the mini quilt raffle will be back!

50th Anniversary Table

Be sure to visit the 50th anniversary table, where many opportunities await! LQG polo shirts will be available for \$27. We will have a range of sizes on hand, and if we run out, we can order more to be picked up in May. Also at the 50th anniversary table will be the Nifty Fifty Fat Quarter Raffle. We have 10 boxes that each contains at least 30 fat quarters. Purchase a raffle ticket for \$4 (or get 3 tickets for \$10) and put your ticket in the box for the fat quarters you want to win. Tickets will be sold from April to September, and drawings will be held at the September guild meeting. Bring some address labels so you can fill out your fat quarter raffle tickets in a flash. April 11th Workshop - Thread Painting

We still have spots for Tuesday's thread painting workshop with award-winning quilter Nancy Prince. The guild incurs considerable expenses when bringing in a national speaker. We have travel expenses, hotel expenses, program expenses, and workshop expenses. These programs are not sustainable if we cannot offset the costs with workshop registrations. Our workshop fees are very affordable compared with similar opportunities. At the Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival this summer, a 3-hour Introduction to Thread Painting class with kit is \$85. Our 6-hour class is \$55 on Tuesday (\$71 with the kit), and our class is being taught by a nationally known, award-winning quilter. 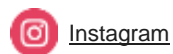
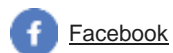
