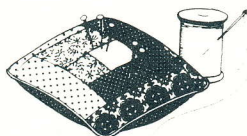
On September 12, 1988...

The ice cream social begins at 6:45 (.50¢ donation)...followed by a....

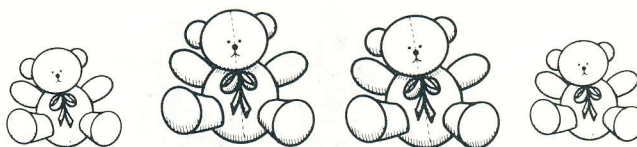


MINI DEMONSTRATION

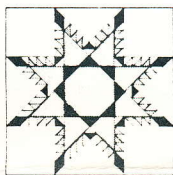

Drinks will be provided.

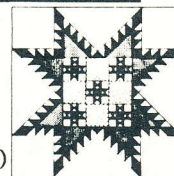
PLACE: College View Seventh Day Adventist Church Fellowship Hall

- * 18" C-thru ruler (B-85),
- * eraser,
- * glue stick,
- * rotary cutter and mat
- * large sheets (17 1/2" x 22") of 1/4" and 1/8" graph paper (can be purchased from me for 25 c ea. in class)
- * BIAS SQUARE (can be purchased in class for \$6.00).
- * Sewing machine and normal sewing supplies.
- * compass,
- * colored pencils,
- * template plastic,
- * #2 lead pencil with sharpener
- * typing paper,
- * paper scissors



FABRIC: At least 1/4 yd of each of three colors (light, medium and dark). Choose prints and/or solids. Bring more choices if you wish.
