**Materials and Tools Needed:**

- Sewing Machine, power cord, foot pedal, machine manual.
- An Open-toe Applique foot (this foot is u-shaped. You must have this foot for class)
- Basic Sewing Kit
- Fabrics *in color of your choice* for the project: 1 fat quarter of background fabric. Scraps of fabric for the flowers, leaves and stems -- they should be at least fat eighths in size. Three greens for stems and leaves, two fabrics for carnations, and four fabrics for center flower.
- Thread to match your Appliqué fabrics (cotton thread): I use 28 wt. Aurifil thread (gray spool) or Mettler 50 wt. (I do not use Aurifil 50 wt. for Machine Applique it would be too thin, and I don't use rayon threads for the same reason). You can use Aurifil 28 wt. I will have several spools and colors of 28 wt. Aurifil thread for sale in the classroom
- 5 – 7 empty bobbins
- Small sharp scissors
- Microtex 80/12 sewing machine needle (Schmetz)

**The kit (\$20) I will provide includes:**

- Carnation pattern (no extra charge for the pattern - it's included in the kit)
- Soft Fuse fusible web sheets (so you can see if you like using it)
- Self-threading needle
- Cleaning brush
- Pencil (I bring my favorite pencil to share with you, and a pencil sharpener)
- Starch (so you don't need to bring it)
- And any other little notions that I know may be necessary for your success, so you don't have to bring those with you.
- Oh - and I bring chocolate. : )

**A note on irons in the classroom:**

While irons will be provided, I recommend bringing your own tabletop iron and pressing surface so you have your own to work with and don't have to share. If you don't have one, then plan on using the classroom irons (they'll be fine, and there will be enough for those who don't bring one). Your pressing surface should be hard like a June Tailor one that has a cutting surface on the other side, or a Steady Betty - soft surfaces just don't work as well as hard ones. Please do not bring the Clover little tiny wand-style iron - it will not get hot enough for this project.
