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Supply List

Fabric: 5 complete repeats of fabric of your choice. Using something with a lot of background does not work as well as one with lots of activity in the fabric. To find the repeat, pick a motif (like a flower, animal, etc.) close to the cut edge, moving along the selvage find the same shape, the distance between those two items is 1 repeat. Make sure you have included 5 of that motif in your cut of fabric. Choose something with different colors and shapes so that you will have a good variety of blocks. Some fabrics have a close repeat of 4-6" while some have up to 12" or more, the farther apart the repeat, the more fabric you will need. Usually, 2 to 2 ½ yards will be sufficient. It is fun to have some extra to show what the original fabric looked like.

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies, scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.
- Rotary cutter with a new, sharp blade. You will be cutting through 4 layers of fabric at a time
- Flat head pins (also known as flower pins)
- Long rotary cutting ruler and also a smaller one (6 ½ x 6 ½ or so will be fine)
- Cutting mat, medium to large size
