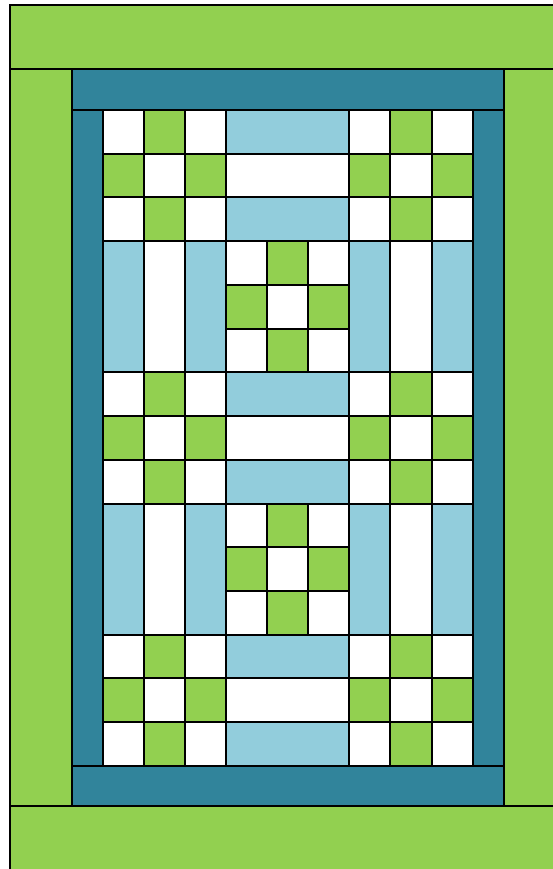
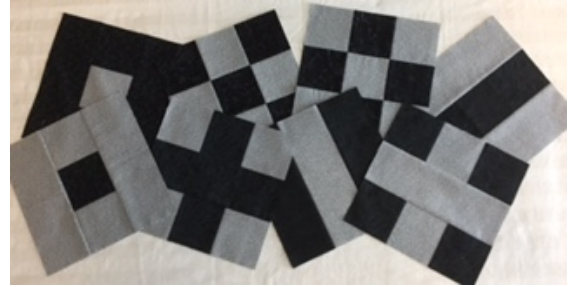

# Stash Buster Quilts with Mix & Match Blocks - 6 hour workshop

Make a dent in your stash by stitching a 40" x 58" quilt with 15 blocks and two borders. Choose your own colors and fabrics and create your own design by combining two simple, versatile block patterns that create an interesting secondary design. Construction focuses on strip piecing with attention to grainline. Dozens of block combination. These designs are suited to a full range of fabrics and looks, from traditional to modern. Fun for all skill levels.



## SUPPLIES

- Cutting: rotary cutter (28mm or 45mm), rotary cutting mat (18" x 24" or larger), and acrylic rotary ruler (24" long and 3½" wide or up to 6½" wide), scissors for snipping threads
- Stitching: sewing machine and extra needles (80/12 Universal or Topstitch or Microtex), coordinating sewing thread
- Other: extra fine glass head quilting pins (.05mm thickness and 1½" to 2" length), container or pin cushion to hold pins, seam ripper, project box (at least 11" x 11" – a new pizza box will work)
- Fabric: total of 2 yards of two or more different 100% cotton fabrics for blocks (details provided prior to workshop.) Also ½ or ¾ yard for inner border, 7/8 yard for outer border, ½ yard for binding, and 1¾ yard for backing.

Rail/Dash		<p>Left:  <math>16 \frac{1}{2}'' + 4'' = \frac{5}{8} \text{ yard DARK value}</math>  <math>9 \frac{1}{2}'' + 4'' = \frac{3}{8} \text{ yard LIGHT value}</math></p> <p>Right:  <math>16 \frac{1}{2}'' + 4'' = \frac{5}{8} \text{ yard LIGHT value}</math>  <math>9 \frac{1}{2}'' + 4'' = \frac{3}{8} \text{ yard DARK value}</math></p>

## YARDAGE FOR BORDERS, BINDING, BACKING:

### Wide (5" finished) Outer Border:

7/8 yard (with side borders having 3 pieces/2 seams)

### Narrow (1-1/2 finished) Inner Border: *See Note*

1/2 yard (with side borders having 5 pieces each) OR

3/4 yard (with side border having 2 pieces each)

### Binding (depends on the width): *See Note*

3/8 yard for cut width of 2" (finished width of approximately 1/4")

1/2 yard for cut width of 2-1/2" (finished width of approximately 3/8")

5/8 yard for cut width of 3" (finished width of approximately 1/2")

**NOTE:** *If 3/4 yards of fabric is purchased for the Narrow Inner Border, the left over fabric is sufficient for any of the three binding widths.*

**Backing:** 1-3/4 yard for finished quilt, which is 40" wide and 58" long. This yardage includes the extra 3 inches needed for machine quilting, especially longarm quilting.

**NOTE:** 4" of additional length has already been added to all yardage amounts.  
If the same fabric is used in both sets of blocks, waste may be factored into only one set.

### \*Rail/Dash: 8 Horizontals

Dark Block: 14" + 4" = 1/2 yard DARK value

7" + 4" = 3/8 yard LIGHT value

Light Block: 3/8 yard LIGHT and 3/8 yard DARK

### \*Rail/Dash: 8 Vertical

Dark Block: 19" + 4" = 5/8 yard DARK value

9 1/2" + 4" = 3/8 yard LIGHT value

Light Block: 5/8 yard LIGHT and 3/8 yard DARK
