



Quilts of Valor – At the March meeting, Sara Kenny asked the Lincoln Quilt Guild to make 135 quilts for the all-female Veterans Honor Flight. If you are only making the top, it needs to be finished by June. If making a finished quilt it needs to be turned in by August. Each quilt will be presented in a pillowcase. One hundred thirty-five pillowcases will also need to be made. Generally, a QOV is a lap-size quilt: Minimum size: 55" x 65", Maximum size: 72" x 90".
