This lecture will serve as an introduction for those interested in creating pictorial quilts based on photographs. Topics covered will include selection of inspiration photos: what to look for and what to avoid. The lecture will address the following photo editing topics: cropping and the use of the "Rule of Thirds", grayscale, posterizing and resizing. Additionally, the lecture will address important concepts related to color, such as color scheme, value, and temperature. Finally, the discussion will turn to elements of composition to include line, balance, contrast, and repetition. The lecture will conclude with a question and answer session.



October Workshop

Workshop: Thread Painted Portraits

Instructor: Lea McComas

Use free-motion stitching on a printed fabric foundation to thread paint a portrait. Begin with a basic blending and contour exercises before moving on to the stitching individual facial features. Learn how to select appropriate threads and how stitching lines can be blended and contoured to create a realistic facial image. Additionally, learn tricks for adding detail and ways of manipulating the background to support the overall composition. The workshop also includes instruction on photo editing as well as larger, more complex, or multiple projects.
