- The winning ticket will be drawn on July 18 as previously published, and the winner will be notified. We will announce the winner at the August meeting.

Mask-Making Update - INCREDIBLE RESPONSE

I am so thrilled to be able to share the latest report from Sheila Green about the amazing work that Lincoln Quilters Guild, Lincoln Modern Quilt Guild, and many other sewing friends all working together are accomplishing for our community.

Over **3,000** masks, **232** scrub caps, **149** hospital gowns, and **6 pair** of surgery shoe covers have been created and donated so far!!!!

These numbers don't even include the untold number of masks that quilters are creating for themselves and their families and friends. This pandemic has created new and important partnerships between sewists and the community helpers all around us.

Handmade items have been donated to Bryan Health, Lancaster County Mental Health Crisis Center, Lancaster Detention Center, Lancaster County Sheriffs, Tabitha Health Care, Home Health Care Assistance, Czech Village in Wilber, St. Elizabeth Hospital, Freedom Health Care, Independence House, Barnabas Community, International Quilt Museum, People's City Mission, Lincoln Fire and Rescue, Tabitha Meals on Wheels, Center Pointe, Child Advocacy Center, Foster Care Closet, University of NE, Lincoln Office for Early Childhood, and Madonna Rehab Hospital.

You can still create and donate masks and other items. Requests continue to

arrive. Contact Sheila at 402-440-3127 to drop off finished items, donate supplies, or pick up supplies (including elastic for items to be donated through this project) from the tote on her porch. Finished items can also be dropped off at Cosmic Cow.

We will keep you updated on the plans for the rest of the Guild year.
