GOOD NEWS!

The guild meeting for August is NOT cancelled. We are planning to meet with some restrictions that are based upon the Nebraska guidelines currently in place.

- The room will be set up with chairs arranged in groups of 8.
- Each group will be 6 feet apart.
- Everyone is asked to wear a mask, unless you are at the podium speaking.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at various places in the room.
- To prevent congregating at the round tables, we are only having 4 tables set up for drop offs and pick-ups. (Programs, Quilt of Valor, Cuddles, and IQM). These will be set up in the lobby to provide extra room for the chair arrangements in the Heartland Room.
- No Mini-Raffle at this meeting.
- One person will check off the membership rosters at the entrance to prevent multiple people handling pens.
- We are canceling the Show and Tell at this meeting to prevent handling of the quilts by the Holders and Folders.
- Watch your email for changes to this plan if the Nebraska guidelines are updated.



The **August 10** speaker, **Tony Jacobson**, is a nationally known quilt designer and teacher. His quilt designs have appeared in *Fons & Porter's Love of Quilting*, *Easy Quilts*, and *Quilting Quickly*. He likes to teach his students how to let the fabric do most of the work so that the finished quilt looks more intricate than the piecing needed to complete the quilt. He works with the Quilts of Valor Foundation as the Graphic Designer in charge of laying out the monthly newsletter and creates many designs that are appropriate for Quilts of Valor. Raffle Quilt

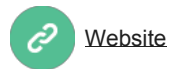
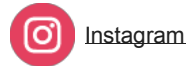
- Get your Raffle Quilt tickets now. There's only a few left! The drawing will be held on Facebook Live on Saturday, July 18 at 5:00 pm.
