I recently took the opportunity to visit the History Nebraska Museum, formerly the Nebraska History Museum, to see the Color Quest Exhibit featuring the Nebraska Windmill block by E.S “Bud” Dunklau designated the official quilt block in 1977 by the state legislature. Bud and Carol Dunklau gave the original block pattern and rights to the pattern to LQG and gave the original cloth block to the Nebraska State Historical Society.
