### **LINCOLN QUILTERS GUILD MEETING Monday, June 17, 2019 International Quilt Study Center & Museum**

President Christina Chapman called a short business meeting to order at 6:15 pm and welcomed everyone to member appreciation night. This meeting provided an opportunity to see the museum collections, enjoy dairy store ice cream and have social time with guild member quilting friends.

#### **Old Business**

1. President Chapman asked for approval of the May, 2019 LQG meeting minutes. Vicky Skuodas moved and Linda Gale seconded the motion to approve the minutes. All were in favor of approving minutes and none opposed.
2. There were no corrections offered to the March 2019 treasurer's report which will now be remanded for audit.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

President-elect Announcements – Lisa Burham: June 15, 2019, five LQG members and one guest participated in a sew day at the museum to make quilt tops for Nebraska flood victims. A sign identifying the sewers as Lincoln Quilt Guild members was displayed and information sheets about the guild were available for museum visitors. Members can donate quilts of any size for the flood victim collection at the August LQG meeting. Donations of quilts of any size, batting, thread and fabrics will be collected at the August meeting and given to the fundraisers.

### **Announcements and Committee Reports**

Bernina Certificate – Linda Gale: The Bernina Store's donated \$25 gift certificate was awarded

IQSCM Liaison - Ann Hauder was pleased to welcome LQG members to the museum. She reviewed the current collections and galleries to visit.

Starting in the Gottsch Gallery, be sure to visit the exhibition ***Los Desconocidos: The unknowns*** – Made by the Migrant Quilt Project starting in 2000, each quilt represents the people who died in a particular year while crossing the Arizona desert after crossing the US-Mexico border. Spend time reading the names of the migrants who were identified and the work for those who are unknown. March 15th and June 27th.

In the center gallery, which was recently for one of LQG's own, Doris Von Seggern, you will find the exhibition ***LIZ AXFORD: OVERLAY***. These whole cloth quilts with hand-dyed surfaces are integrated by dense single-color quilting. Go be inspired by the other worldly light she achieves in her quilts. May 17 - September 22.

The exhibition in the Coryell Gallery is currently being changed out. We can't go in there but you can peak in and see where they are in the process.

In the Beavers Gallery by the elevator, view the 30 small pieces made by SAQA members to celebrate their 30th anniversary of SAQA, Studio Art Quilt Associates. April 2 - August 4.

Head up the elevator to the third floor and see ***150 YEARS OF RED AND WHITE***, celebrating the 150th anniversary of the University of Nebraska. April 16 – September 8.

Finally, be sure to visit the Pumphrey Gallery downstairs off the gift shop to view ***Kathy Caraccio: Quilt Series***. The artist creates colorful printed paper, butts the paper into shapes and arranges them into quilt-like designs and

patterns. Her collages may provide you with new inspiration. April 24 – September 29.

2020 Quilt Show – Vicky Skuodas announced the Sesostris Temple had a schedule conflict the new date of for the LQG Quilt Show will be July 17-18, 2020. The Sesostris Temple is located at Highway 77 and Saltillo Road.

Vicky Skuodas reminded members that the July Cuddle Quilts will be held June 28th from 9am to 2pm due to the July 4th holiday.

Programs - Marilyn Schnepf and Julie Albrect asked members to show and discuss their projects from this year's classes.

Members were reminded of the upcoming programs that are listed on the LQG website.
