Lincoln Quilters Guild Meeting Monday, July 12, 2021 College View Seventh Day Adventist Church

The meeting was called to order by President Lisa Burham with attendees and guests welcomed to the Guild meeting. Guests were invited to consider joining the guild. If guests pursued membership that evening they would be able to join for \$20 in addition to the \$5 guest fee.

Old Business

- Lisa announced that no approval was needed for June minutes due to the fact that June was Member Appreciation Night and no business meeting was held.
- Included in the July Plain Print was the Treasurer's Report for May and June. Seeing no questions or corrections, the report will be remanded for audit.

New Business

Announcements:

Connie Soucie - President elect announced the following:

- Book Sale during the August 9th meeting:
 - Members were encouraged to come early to the August meeting (6:15pm) if they wish to drop off any quilting books they want to donate.
 - Proceeds will be used for guild activities.
 - o Any books not sold will be donated to Lincoln City Libraries.

• Isles Sale - August 8th from 10 to 3:

- Fliers with location and times were available on the information table and meeting chairs.
- Cost of admission to the sale will be an item for the Food Bank.
- o Several different vendors with sewing/fabric items will be for sale.
- o Proceeds from the LQG booth will benefit the guild.

Webmaster/Email publisher opening was announced – requiring computer skills, editing skills, communication skills:

- Connie announced that Chris Wiegers, who is responsible for the guild's website and email formatting, would like to retire from the job. Although this is currently a combined role, it could be divided between 2 people (website and email).
- These roles are essential to guild communication and members were encouraged to notify Lisa if they have an interest in the role(s) as soon as possible.

Nebraska State Quilt Guild request for quilts to display in Kearney on October 8th and 9th:

- One quilt was offered for display at the Threads Across Nebraska quilt show (sponsored by NSQG).
- Fourteen quilts have been requested from LQG.
- Zoom Mini Classes were announced for Saturday 10/2 and Sunday 10/3:
 - Members were informed that the guild has paid the registration for a second opportunity to participate in a virtual sampler platter on October 2nd and 3rd.
 - More information will soon be available at the Information Table.

- Members were encouraged to wear nametags to facilitate meeting other guild members.
