Committee Reports

Quilt Show, Natalie Cummings & Sheila Green

1. Sheila Green and Natalie Cummings announced results of the quilt show. Even though the Quilt Show was a day shorter than other years, and did not include a silent auction, the outcomes were very comparable to previous shows. Last minute parking lot resurfacing appeared to be the only negative. There were approximately 625 attendees. Eighty items were donated for the live auction. There were 320 total quilts with 182 of them registered by members. Leadership committee included 22 members with 97 on site volunteers. All of the 2500 tickets for the raffle quilt donated by Vicki Skuodas and Joan Yoder, quilted by Joyce Nass, were sold. Net revenue is more than \$11,500.

Quilts of Valor, Sara Kenny

1. Sara announced that 135 Quilts have been made for the 12th Honor Flight on September 24 in Nebraska. LQG members involved in making these quilts numbered 79. Sara congratulated LQG for their hard work.
