

# SemiQuiltennial Quilt



- This quilt is one way our guild will celebrate the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the USA.
- All blocks should be 6  $^{1}/_{2}$ " for a finished size of 6" once the quilt is assembled.
- We're asking that members complete 2 or 3 blocks in red, white & blue (no tans/off-whites).
- Colors do not have to match the colors indicated in the pattern.
- Return all blocks to Tammy Hensley no later than the November 2025 guild meeting.
- Blocks must be returned in the paper bags provided with your name on the bag.
- Please write your name on the included tags and pin them to the back of each block.
- When printing out instructions it needs to be printed out at 100% not fit to print or scaled particularly on the last few pages/patterns which are paper pieced or require a template (Six Point Star, Five Point Star, Nine Patch Star, Broken Star, Northumberland Star).
- You can print out just the pages for only the blocks you want to make. It is not necessary to print out the whole document.
- The quilt will be assembled and quilted and will be the 2026 LQG Raffle Quilt. Proceeds will be donated to a veterans organization.

#### **Background** color

 $1 - 3^{1}/4$ " square

4 - 2 1/2" squares (corners)

 $5 - 1^{1}/4$ " squares (nine patch center)







Arrange one Color  $1 - 3^1/4$ " square and the Background Color  $3^1/4$ " square right sides together. Repeat with one Color  $1 - 3^1/4$ " square and the Color  $2 - 3^1/4$ " square. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. Arrange one of each color combination HST as shown above. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press.



Arrange 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares as shown to create center 9 patch block. Arrange block elements as shown at right to form rows and then sew rows together to complete block.




## Aunt Eliza's Star




Arrange each Color  $1 - 3^{1}/4$ " square with each Color  $2 - 3^{1}/4$ " square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. Arrange the HSTs as shown above. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press.

Arrange block elements as shown at right to form rows and then sew rows together to complete block.

#### **Background** color

6 - 2" squares (corners)

 $1 - 4^{1}/_{4}$ " square

#### Color 1

4 - 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square

#### Color 2

2 - 2" squares

We're going to make our Flying Geese star points using the four at a time method.



Draw a diagonal line down the center of all Color  $1 - 2^3/8$ " squares. Arrange two of the Color  $1 - 2^3/8$ " squares on opposite corners of the Background Color  $4^1/4$ " square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have two of the pieces as shown above.

Place the remaining Color 1 -  $2\sqrt[3]{8}$ " squares on the two cut and pressed halves as shown at right. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of




the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have four completed flying geese.



Arrange the Color 2 squares with the remaining Background Color 2" squares as shown at left to form the center of the block. Arrange rows as shown at right to complete the block.









Arrange each Color 1 - 3  $^{1}/_{4}$ " square with each Background Color 3  $^{1}/_{4}$ " square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch  $^{1}/_{4}$ " away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. Arrange the HSTs as shown above. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch  $^{1}/_{4}$ " away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press.

Arrange block elements as shown at right to form rows and then sew rows together to complete block.

4 - 2" squares (corners)

 $1 - 4^{1}/_{4}$ " square

#### Color 1

1 - 3 1/2" square (center)

#### Color 2

4 - 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares

We're going to make our Flying Geese star points using the four at a time method.

Draw a diagonal line down the




center of all Color  $2 - 2^3/8$ " squares. Arrange two of the Color  $2 - 2^3/8$ " squares on opposite corners of the Background Color  $4^1/4$ " square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have two of the pieces as shown above.

Place the remaining Color 2 -  $2^{3}/8$ " squares on the two cut and pressed halves as shown at right. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of




the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have four completed flying geese.

Arrange block elements as shown at right to form rows and then sew rows together to complete block.


Arrange all Color 1 & Color 2 squares with a corresponding  $3^{1}/4^{\circ}$  Background Color square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch  $1/4^{\circ}$  away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. Arrange the HSTs as shown above. Draw a diagonal line down the center. Stitch  $1/4^{\circ}$  away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press.




Arrange Color 3 & Background Color 3" squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line down

the center. Stitch  $^1/_4$ " away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press.

Arrange block elements as shown at right to form rows and then sew rows together to complete block.



We're going to make our Flying Geese star points using the four at a time method. Draw a diagonal line down the




center of all Color  $2 - 2^3/8$ " squares. Arrange two of the Color  $2 - 2^3/8$ " squares on opposite corners of the Background Color  $4^1/4$ " square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have two of the pieces as shown above.

Place the remaining Color 2 -  $2\sqrt[3]{8}$ " squares on the two cut and pressed halves as shown at right. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of




the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have four completed flying geese.

# Crystal Star continued




Now we'll make our center diamond. Draw a diagonal line on each of the Color 3 - 2" squares. Place two of the Color 3 squares on opposite corners of the Color 2 - 3  $^{1}/_{2}$ " square right sides together. Stitch on the drawn line. Cut  $^{1}/_{4}$ " away from your stitched line on both corners and press.




Repeat the above process on the remaining corners.

Arrange block elements as shown at right to form rows and then sew rows together to complete block.












Draw a diagonal line down the center of four Background Color 2" squares. Arrange two of the Background Color 2" squares on each of the Color 2 rectangles as shown above. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim  $^1/_4$ " away from the stitched line as shown and press.











Repeat the above steps with the Background Color 2" squares and Color 3 rectangles.

## Woven Star continued




Draw two diagonal lines down the center the Background Color  $3^3/8$ " square as shown above. Arrange two of the Background Color square on the Color  $1 - 3^3/8$ " square right sides together. Stitch a 1/4" seam around the outside of the squares. Cut along both diagonal lines to create four Half Square Triangles and press.



Arrange HSTs, Background Color squares, and Color 2 & 3 rectangles as shown above and stitch together to complete each quarter of the block. Arrange sections as shown above and stitch together to complete the Woven Star block.

We're going to make our Flying Geese star points using the four at a time method. Draw a diagonal line down the



center of all Color 1 - 1  $^{7}/_{8}$ " squares. Arrange two of the Color 1 - 1  $^{7}/_{8}$ " squares on opposite corners of the Color 2 - 3  $^{1}/_{4}$ " square right sides together. Stitch  $^{1}/_{4}$ " away on both sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have two of the pieces as shown above.


Place the remaining Color 1 -  $1^{7}/_{8}$ " squares on the two cut andpressed halves as shown at right. Stitch  $^{1}/_{4}$ " away on both



sides of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line and press. You'll have four completed flying geese.

## **Amish Star continued**










Draw two diagonal lines down the center the of Color 1-  $2^{5}/8$ " squares as shown above. Arrange two of the Color 1 squares on the Color  $2 - 2^{5}/8$ " squares right sides together. Stitch a  $^{1}/_{4}$ " seam around the outside of the squares. Cut along both diagonal lines to create eight Half Square Triangles and press.




Arrange HSTs with Color  $2 - 1 \frac{1}{2}$  squares as shown at left to complete four corner sections of Amish Star block.




Arrange Flying Geese with Color 1 - 1  $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 2  $^{1}/_{2}$ " pieces asshown at left to complete four sections.

Arrange completed sections and center square into rows as shown at right. Arrange rows as shown and stitch together to complete the Amish Star block.




# Friendship Star



Center Square - (1)  $2^{1}/2^{n}$  square Corner Squares - (4)  $2^{1}/2^{n}$  squares Star Points -

- (2)  $3^{3}/8$ " squares coordinating color
- (2) 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares that match corner square color

Draw diagonal line down center of star point squares. Layer squares right sides together with coordinating color squares. Stitch <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" from both sides of center line. Cut on drawn line to create 2 half square triangles. Repeat.



Arrange all squares as shown in example above to complete the block.


## Four Point Star



Background -  $(4) 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares Star Points - (4) 3" squares



Fold Star Point squares in half diagonally right sides together. Stitch 1/4" from seam down one side.




Trim inside corner point and turn point right side out. Center seam on back side and press. Edge stitch or applique point to background square. Stitch completed quarters together as shown above.


Front View of Point





Background - 24 triangles Star - 12 triangles




Triangle Template








Triangles (G) - 2 - 3" cut in half diagonally 5 completed paper pieced templates

Center - (1) 2" square (1) 2 <sup>3</sup>/8" square

#### White Background Fabric

Background Corners - (4) 2" squares (1) 2 <sup>3</sup>/8" square

enough to complete 5 paper pieced sections

#### Red Stripe Fabric

enough to complete 5 paper pieced sections

#### White Stripe Fabric

enough to complete 5 paper pieced sections

Using the 2 3/8" white background and blue squares arranged right sides together, draw a diagonal line down between two opposite corners and stitch along both sides of that line to create the two at a time half square triangles for the upper left quadrant of the block. Complete all of the provided paper pieced sections and arrange all elements as shown above to complete the block.
