

One Block Wonder Class Supply List

Fabric must have 6 repeats. Most fabric comes with an 8 inch repeat, 12 inch repeat, 18 inch repeat or 24 inch repeat. The bigger the repeat, the bigger your quilt. Do NOT prewash.

*Fabric shop will help you get enough fabric to cover the repeats.

*You will want extra to show the original fabric or use as a border. 2 yards should be enough.

*1 yard of fabric for binding for skinny border and binding.

How to choose fabric: Look for a print that has a lot going on. Lots of colors and variety in the print works so well. A fabric that has some background areas without print but not too much negative space also works well. If you want to know what a certain fabric might look like as a One Block, here is an absolutely fabulous website where you can upload a photo of the actual fabric and see what it will look like cut and made into the hexies.

Large cutting mat 24 x 36

Rotary cutter with NEW blade, you will be cutting through 6 pieces of fabric when making triangles.

60 Degree triangle ruler

Long Ruler 6 ½" x 24"

Ruler approximately 2-1/2 x 6 or something small like this

Flower head pins (a must)

Starch or alternative such as Best Press or Flatter

Basic sewing supplies

Box to put your small pieces in

Iron

Ironing surface
