



## Find The Value In Your Scraps- 6 hr workshop with Blair Stucker of Wise Craft Handmade

This 6 hour workshop will help you to understand light and dark color value and how to use them in a scrappy quilt. In this class we will be making a scrappy value quilt that measures approximately 54" x 67".

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## Materials and supplies you will need for class:

- **Required purchase for our workshop- The Wise Craft Ruby Ruler®**

- 180 5" squares of printed quilting cottons\*- The key to the success of this project is having a large variety of fabrics. The more variety you have, the more successful your quilt will be and the more you will learn about value. **\*Please choose only printed quilting cottons.** This is a great chance to use a print you don't have much of, or one that you don't love but would like to use. These kinds of fabrics work in a quilt like this. (For reference, 180 5" squares will equal about 3½ yards of fabric.)

Ways to get good variety in your scraps-

- Cut squares from your stash (no more than 2 per print)
- Use precut charm packs
- Swap and trade with friends.
- Sewing Machine with a fresh needle and threaded with neutral thread
- Cutting Mat, Rotary Cutter, and a quilting ruler (I like two for this project- a 6" x 12" ruler and a square ruler at least 6").

- One grocery sized brown paper bag (you should be able to grab fabric from inside the bag without seeing what you grabbing)
- Fabric Scissors
- Pins and pincushion
- Seam Ripper
- Marking pen- black Frixion pen, a water soluble marker or a chalk pencil.
- Design Wall or cleared space to lay out your design
