




# Starlight Workshop Supply & Cutting Information

Wall Quilt size: 42" x 42"  
Block size: 12" finished



## Fabrics required (yardage):



**Lights** (Whites were used in photo): 2 yards  
**Bright's**: 1-yard total  
**Darks**: 1-yard total  
**Red border**: ½ yard  
**Backing**: 2 yards; **Batting**: Baby-size

**Blocks**: Starlight (9 Starlight blocks to create the Wall Quilt; For larger quilts, simply make more blocks.)

## Cutting:

### Two Options:

- 1) Either **pull** the following Squares from your Speedy Solutions Scrap Stash
- 2) **OR** rotary **cut** from Yardage or Fat Quarters. (See yardage requirements above)

### Cut or pull the following scrap squares/strips from your Stash for the blocks:

Qty: (9) 4.5" White (Light) squares for center

Qty: (36) 2.5" White (Light) squares

Qty: (36) 2.5" x 4.5" white (Light) rectangles [Either pull 5" squares, cut in half; then trim off ½" length to create (2) 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles from each 5" square]; **OR** pull 2.5" strips of fabric from your Scrap Strips Bin and sub-cut 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles from the strips

Qty: (36) 2.5" squares in Bright colors

Qty: (36) 3" white (Light) squares

Qty: (72) 3" Dark squares

Qty: (36) 3" squares in Bright colors

### Cut for the borders:

Qty: (2) 2.5" x 36.5" White borders; (2) 2.5" x 40.5" White borders

Qty: (2) 1.5" x 40.5" Red borders; (2) 1.5" x 42.5" Red borders
