

Supply List for Tina Curran's "Flower Flag 2" for a quilt that finishes approximately 39" h x 60" w

- Floral fabrics featuring flower heads that don't overlap each other, range in diameter from 1" – 3" and are realistic, cartoonish or somewhere in between (I like a mixture of all three). I used 50 flower heads to match the number of stars on the U.S. flag
- Fabric for the background of the flower field (cut at 22-1/2" x 25-1/2"). I used a small-scale floral fabric
- Muslin (to line any flower heads you can see the background fabric through). I used the bleached white variety
- Between 1/8th of a yard and 3/8ths of a yard of floral fabric for each of 13 flag stripes. Use a mix of medium and large-scale motifs and a mix of lights, mediums and darks
- Sewing thread to blend with the various floral fabrics
- Clear thread for raw-edge appliqué
- Double-sided fusible web (tip: iron fusible web to back of roughly-cut flower heads before fussy cutting them; this way you only fussy cut each flower head once)
- 1-3/4 yards of backing fabric
- 1/2 yard of binding fabric
- A piece of batting larger than 39" x 60"
- Scissors to fussy-cut flower heads
- Rotary cutter, 6" x 12" and 6" x 24" rotary cutter rulers and a rotary cutting mat
- Iron and ironing pad (Teflon ironing sheet optional)
- Sewing machine in good working order and with the ability to do a zigzag stitch
- Any other supplies you usually use while sewing
