

The Border Quilt 4 Class prep

Supplies to Bring

Pattern

Fabric cut for your quilt size

Cutting mat/Rotary cutter

A ruler at least 6 1/2" square

Something to store your cut units in when traveling home

Fabric Needed

Based on 40" fabric width:

Quilt size	Background	Dark	Medium	Light	Backing	Binding
30" x 34"	1 1/8 yards	1/2 yard	1/2 yard	-	1 1/8 yards	1/4 yard
39" x 42"	1 7/8 yards	1/2 yard	1/2 yard	1/2 yard	2 3/4 yards	3/8 yard
54" x 60"	3 1/4 yards	1 yard	1/2 yard	1/2 yard	5 3/4 yards	1/2 yard
72" x 80"	5 1/8 yards	1 yard	1 yard	1 yard	5 yards	5/8 yard
86" x 96"	6 3/4 yards	1 yard	2 3/8 yard	1 yard	3 3/8 yards wide backing	7/8 yard

Cutting – We will be making the 39" x 42" in class, but you can choose to make any size and continue the process after class. If making a larger size, make sure to follow those fabric requirements. If making the 30" x 34" size, stop cutting where indicated.

Center:

Background:

- 1) Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF
 - a. Set aside strips for Strip Piecing
- 2) Cut one 7" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into two 7" squares for HST

Dark 1:

- 3) Cut one 7" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into two 7" squares for HST
 - b. Mark once on the diagonal

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- c. Trim rest of strip down to 6 1/2" X WOF
- d. Sub-cut one 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle
- 4) Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF
 - a. Set aside for Strip Piecing

Border 1:

Background:

- 5) Cut three strips 2 1/2" x WOF
 - a. Sew end to end
 - b. Sub-cut into four 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" border strips

Border 2 – Flying Geese:

Background:

- 6) Cut five 3" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into fifty-six 3" squares
 - i. Mark once on the diagonal

Medium fabrics:

- 7) Cut two strips 5 1/2" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into fourteen 5 1/2" squares

Stop here for 30" x 42"

Border 3:

Background:

- 8) Cut two strips 2" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into two 2" x 34 1/2" border strips
- 9) Cut two strips 1 1/2" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into two 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" border strips

Border 4 – Friendship Star Blocks:

Background:

- 10) Cut five strips 2" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into one hundred 2" squares for HST
- 11) Cut eight strips 1 1/2" x WOF
 - a. Sub-cut into two hundred squares

Light Fabrics:

12) Cut five strips 2" x WOF

- a. Sub-cut into one hundred 2" squares for HST
- b. Mark once on the diagonal

13) Cut two strips 1 1/2" x WOF

- a. Sub-cut into fifty 1 1/2" squares

Stop here for 39" x 42"
