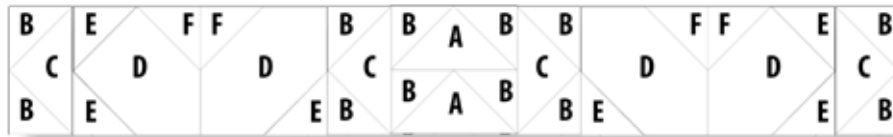


Medallion Frame #4

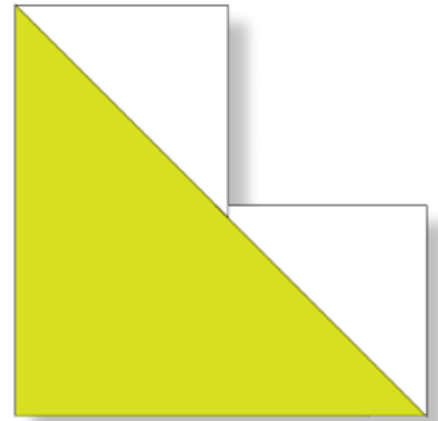
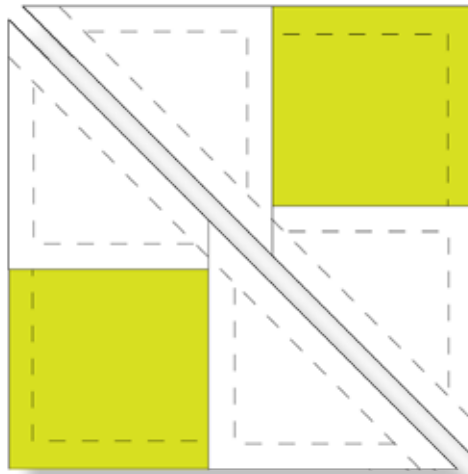
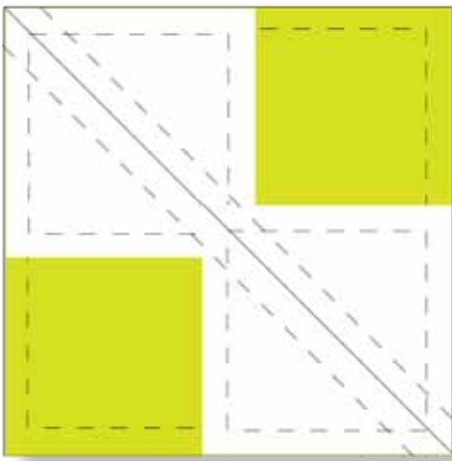


Use the A square and B squares to make Four at a Time Flying Geese blocks. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the B squares and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of the line. Cut along drawn diagonal line and press to make two partial Flying Geese units.

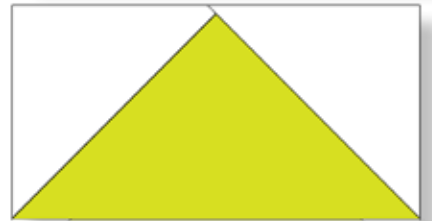
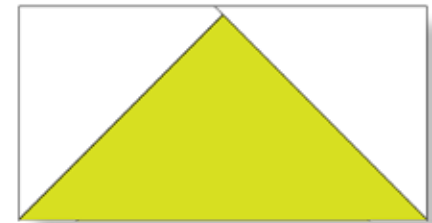
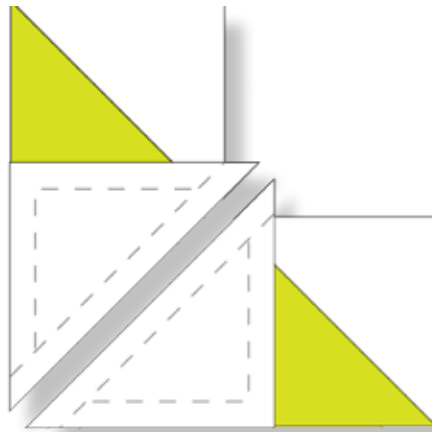
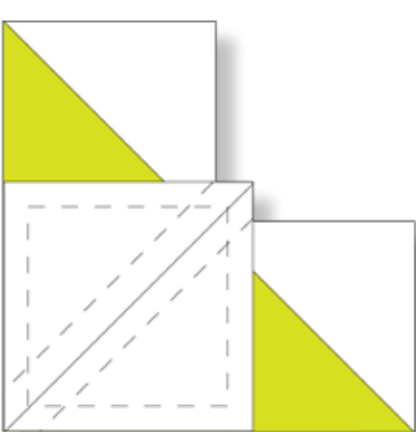
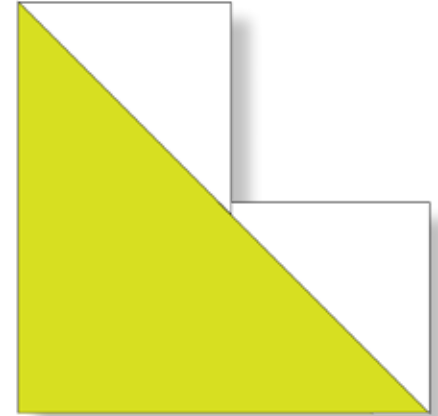


Place another B square with diagonal line as shown above. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of the line. Cut along drawn diagonal line and press to make two Flying Geese units. Repeat to make a total of four Flying Geese blocks.

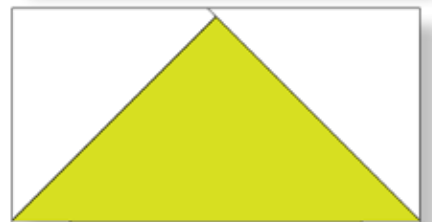
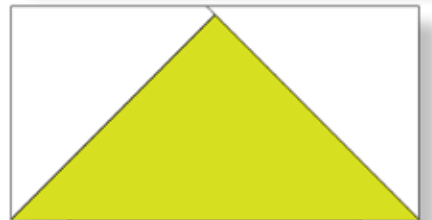


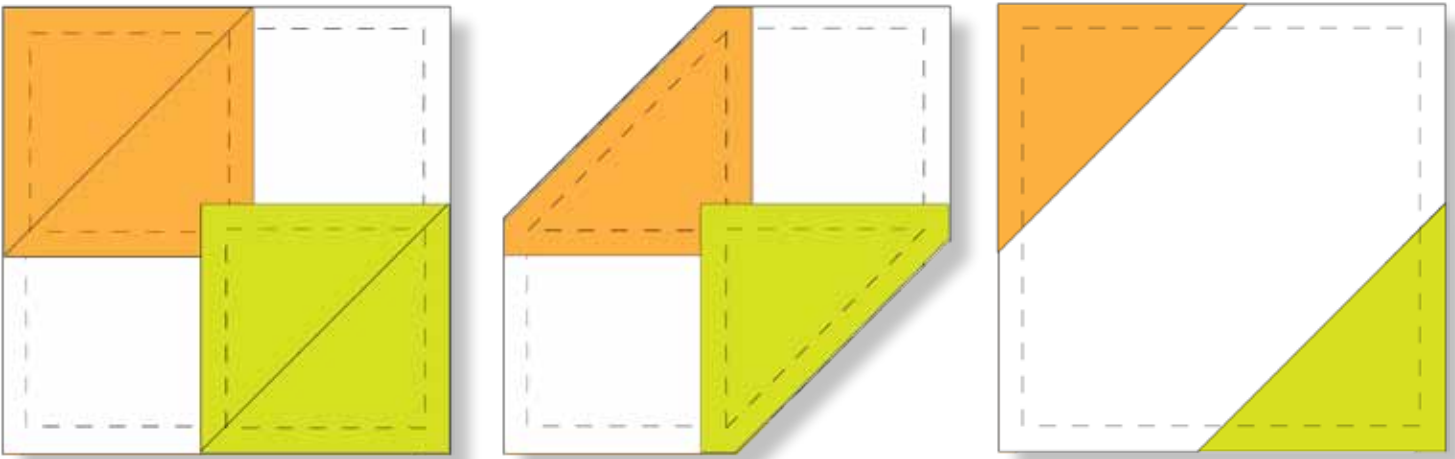


Use a C square and B squares to make Four at a Time Flying Geese blocks. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the B squares and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of the line. Cut along drawn diagonal line and press to make two partial Flying Geese units.

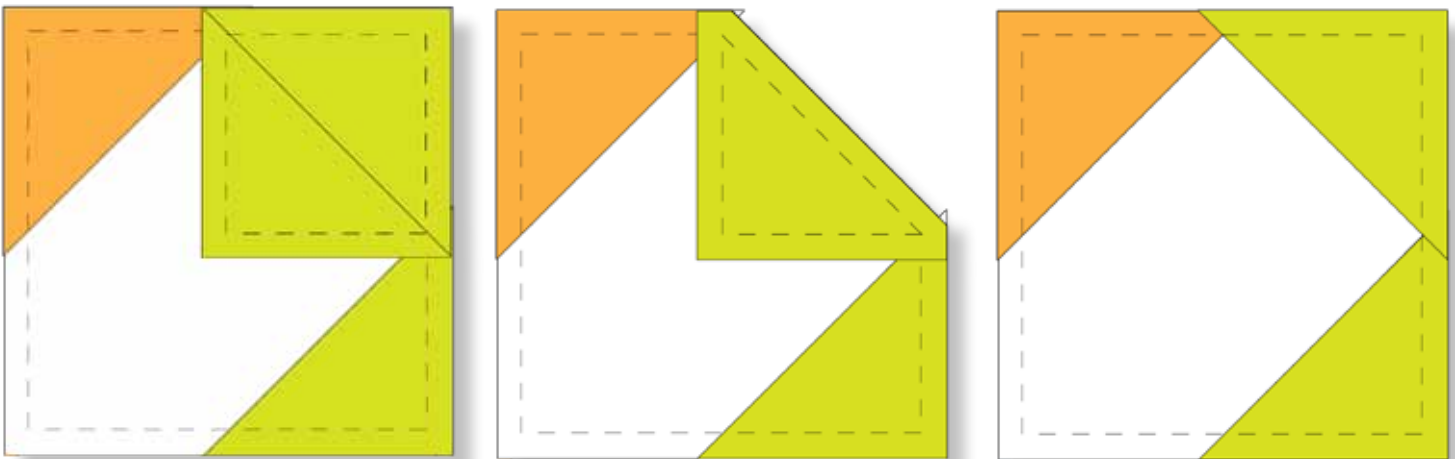


Place another B square with diagonal line as shown above. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of the line. Cut along drawn diagonal line and press to make two Flying Geese units. Repeat to make a total of four Flying Geese blocks. Repeat process with another C square and four B squares until you have eight Flying Geese blocks.

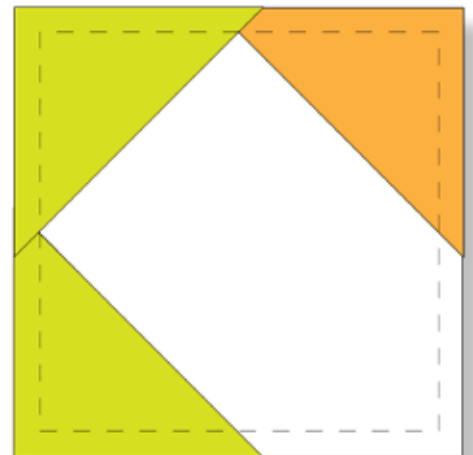


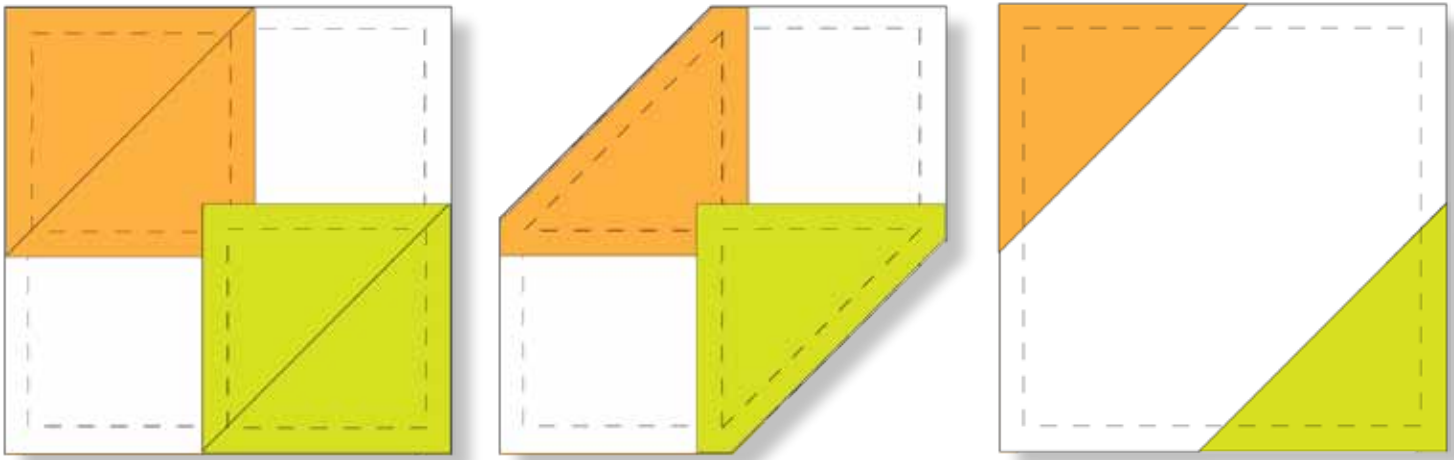


Use a D square, two E squares and an F square to make a partial Diamond Block. and four B squares to make a Diamond Block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the E and F squares. Place an E and F square on opposite sides of a D square, right sides together and stitch along lines. Trim and press.

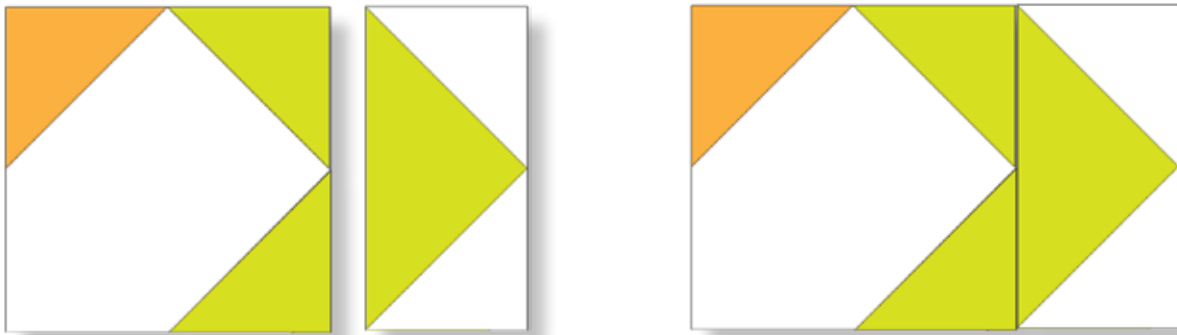


Place the remaining E square on one of the remaining corners. Stitch along the previously drawn diagonal line. Trim and press. Repeat to make a matching block. You will make two additional blocks that are the mirror image of the just completed blocks as shown to the right.

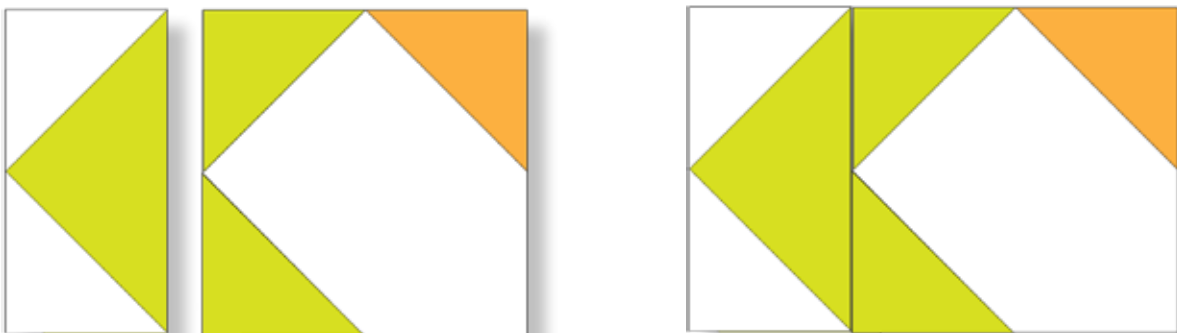




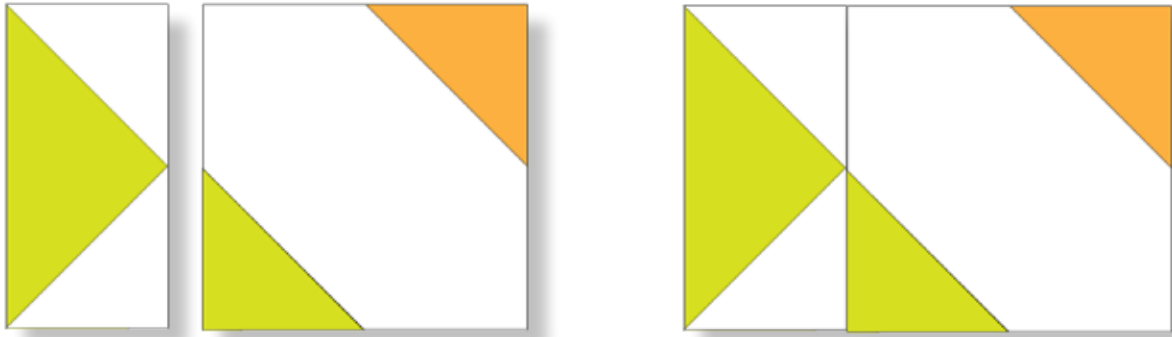
Use a D square, an E square and an F square to make an Angled Block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the C squares. Place two C squares on opposite sides of an A square, right sides together and stitch along lines. Trim as shown and press. Repeat to make three additional blocks.



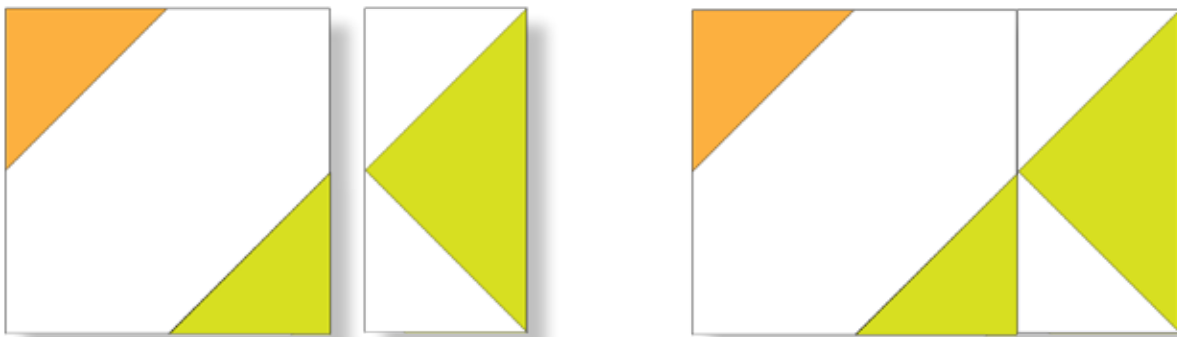
Layout Partial Diamond block and Flying Geese as shown and stitch together. Press. Repeat to make a total of two strips.



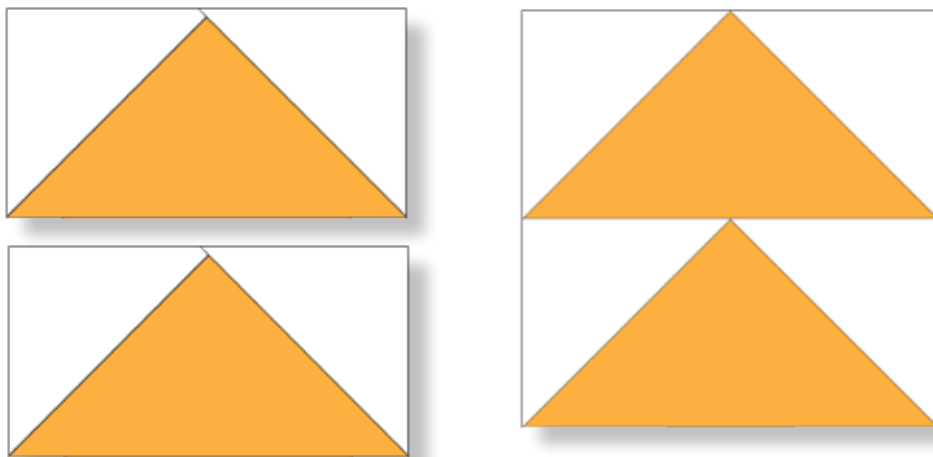
Layout Partial Diamond block and Flying Geese as shown and stitch together. Press. Repeat to make a total of two strips in the mirror image of your first set.



Layout Angled block and Flying Geese as shown and stitch together. Press. Repeat to make a total of two strips.



Layout Angled block and Flying Geese as shown and stitch together. Press. Repeat to make a total of two strips in the mirror image of your first set.



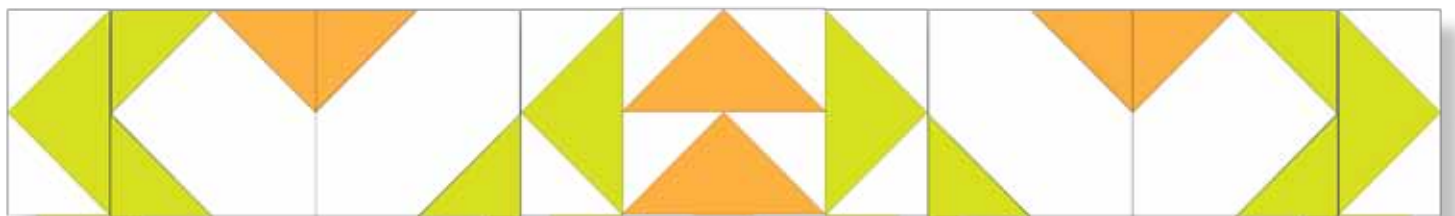
Combine two flying geese to form a square. Complete two squares.



Arrange your completed strip sets as shown and stitch together. Complete two of each set.



Arrange your completed strip sets as shown and stitch together. Complete two of each set to make a mirror image of your first set.



Arrange your completed strip sets and flying geese squares as shown and stitch together. Repeat to make a total of two rows.

Arrange your completed rows with your medallion center as shown and stitch together.
