$1-21 / 2 " \times 20 " \operatorname{strip}(D)$

## Fabric C

8 - 2 $^{1 / 2 "}$ squares (C)
l- $5 \frac{1}{1}$ " square ( F )



Use an A square and four B squares to make a Diamond Block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $B$ squares. Place two B squares on opposite sides of an A square, right sides together and stitch along lines. Trim and press.


Repeat with two remaining B squares on remaining corners. Trim and press. Repeat to make three additional Diamond Blocks.


Use the F square and G squares to make Four at a Time Flying Geese blocks. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $G$ squares and stitch $1 / 4 "$ from both sides of the line. Cut along drawn diagonal line and press to make two partial Flying Geese units.


Place another G square with diagonal line as shown above. Stitch $1 / 4$ " from both sides of the line. Cut along drawn diagonal line and press to make two Flying Geese units. Repeat to make a total of four Flying Geese blocks.


Use an A square and two C squares to make an Angled Block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the C squares. Place two C squares on opposite sides of an A square, right sides together and stitch along lines. Trim as shown and press. Repeat to make three additional blocks.

Stitch D \& E strips together right sides together along long edge. Press and cut into $8-21 / 2 "$ sections.


Join two Flying Geese as shown to complete the center section of the strip. Repeat to make two Flying Geese Blocks.


Layout two Four Patch Blocks with a Flying Geese block as shown. Stitch together as shown completing two sets.


Layout an Angled Block with a Diamond Block as shown and stitch together. Complete four sets.

Layout block sets as shown and stitch together. Press. Repeat to make a total of two strips.
