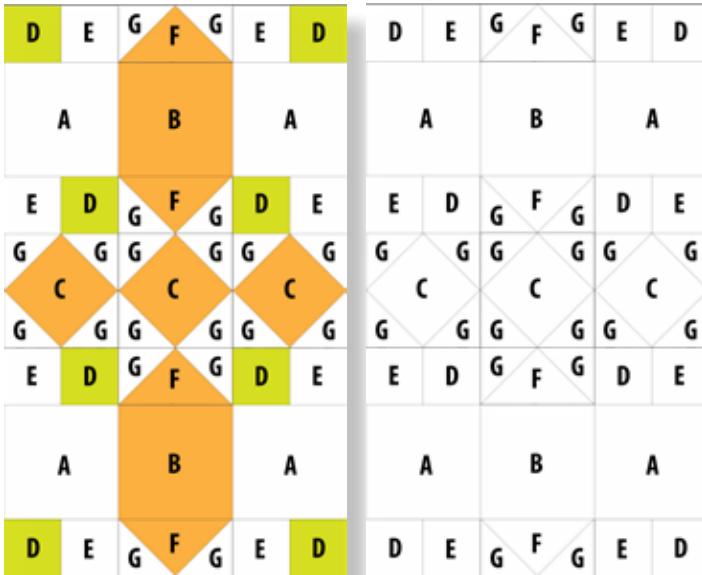


Medallion Center

12" x 20" finished block



Fabric A

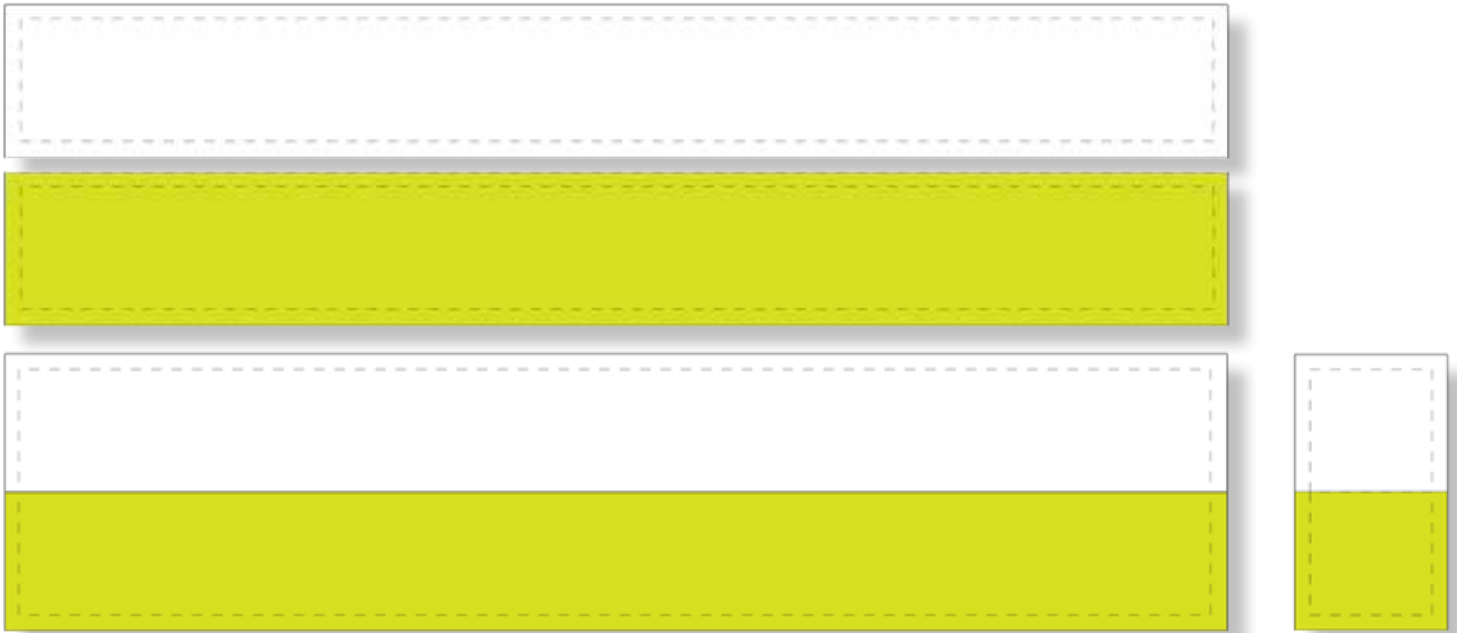
- 4 - 4 1/2" squares (A)
- 20 - 2 1/2" squares (G)
- 1 - 2 1/2" x 20" strip (E)

Fabric B

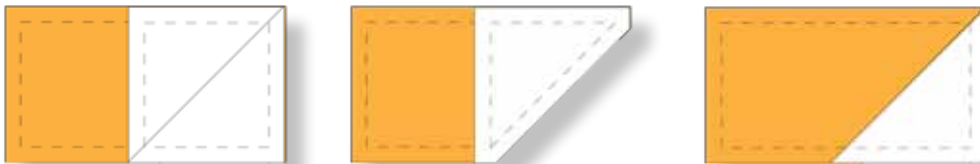
- 1 - 2 1/2" x 20" strip (D)

Fabric C

- 5 - 4 1/2" squares (B & C)
- 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (F)



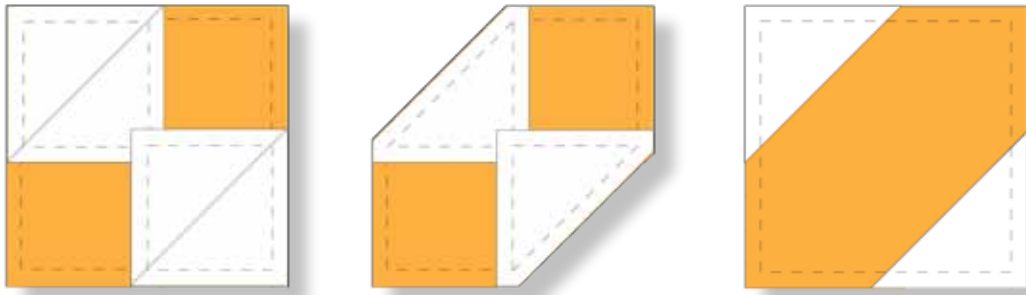
Stitch D & E strips together right sides together along long edge. Press and cut into 8 - 2 1/2" sections.



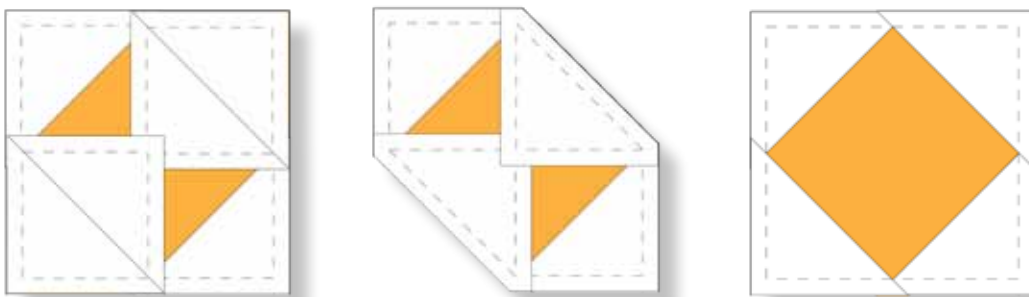
Use the F rectangles and G squares to make Flying Geese blocks. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the G squares and stitch along that line. Trim and press.



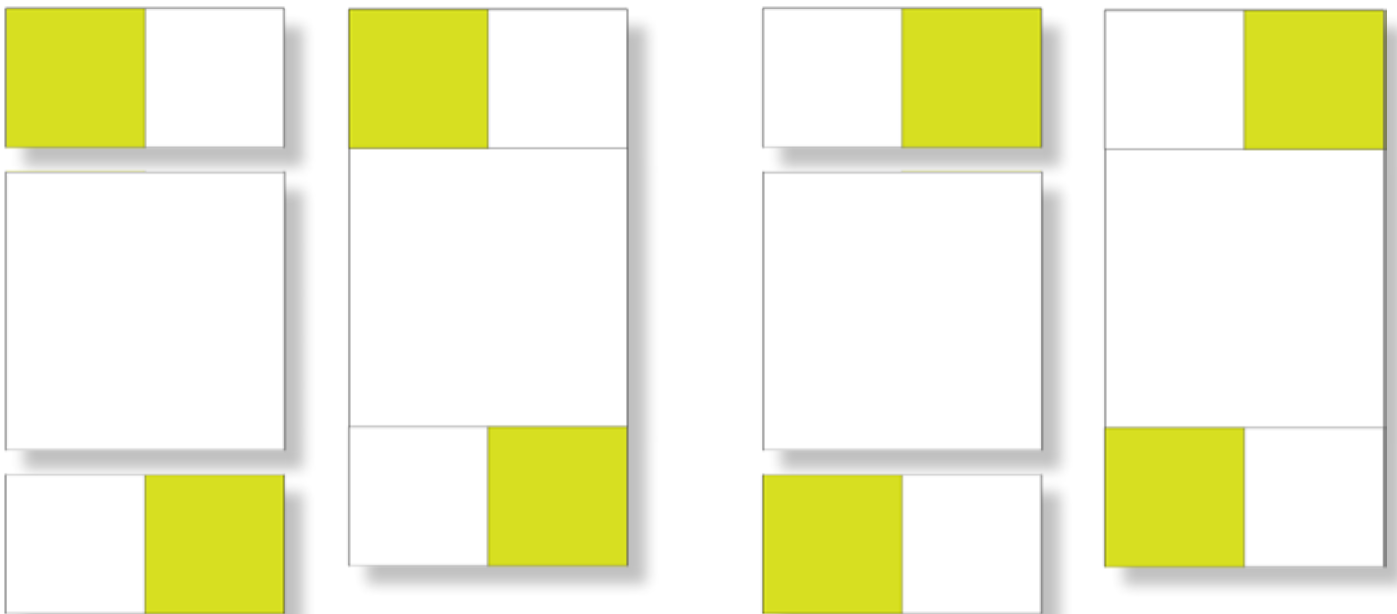
Place another G square with diagonal line on the opposite side of the rectangle. Stitch along that line. Trim and press. Repeat to make three additional Flying Geese.



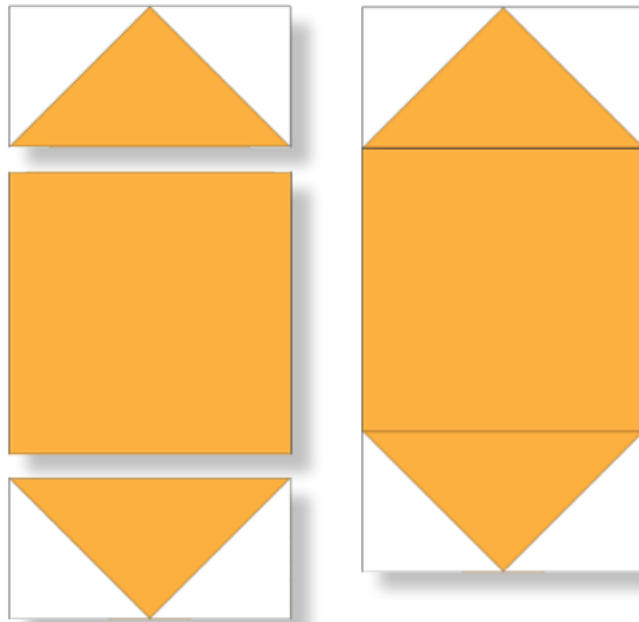
Use a C square and four G squares to make a Diamond Block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the G squares. Place two G squares on opposite sides of a C square, right sides together and stitch along lines. Trim and press.



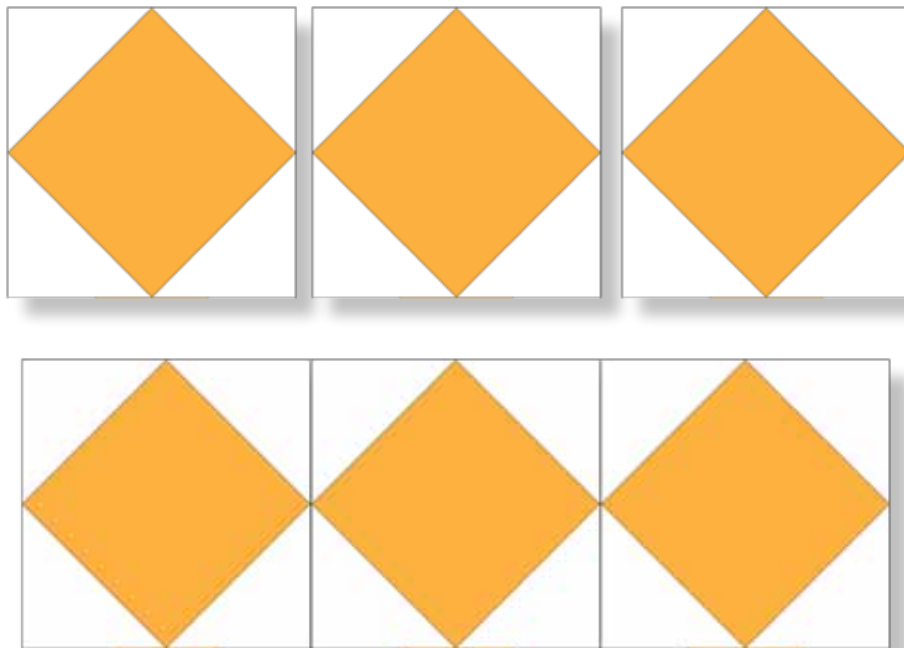
Repeat with two remaining G squares on remaining corners. Trim and press. Repeat to make two additional Diamond Blocks



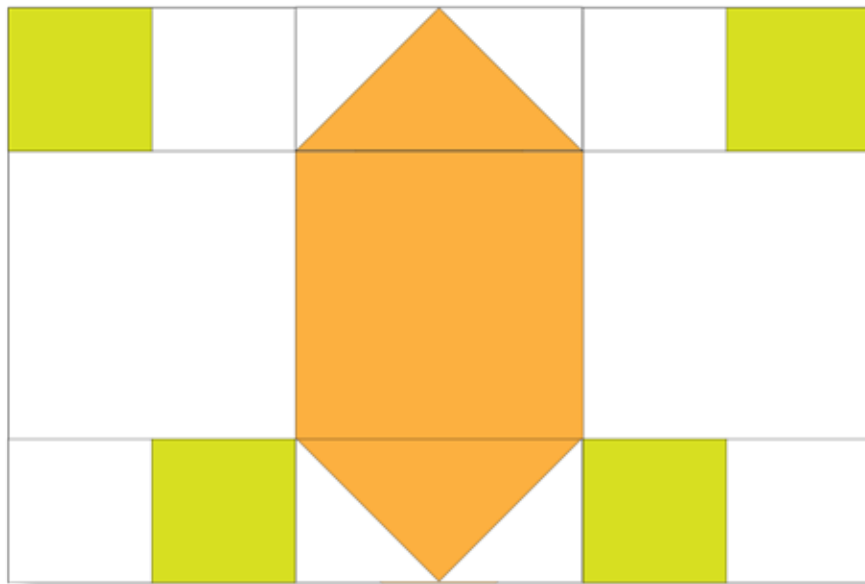
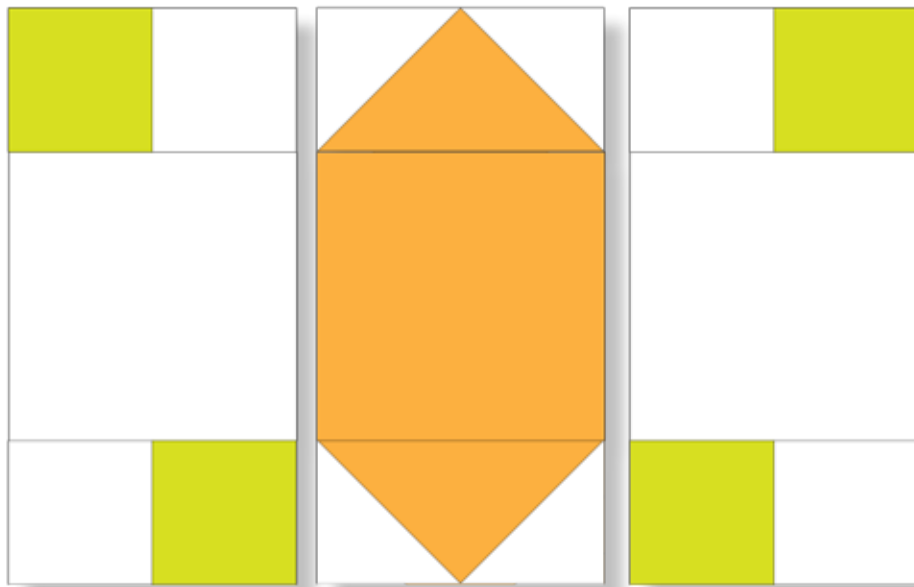
Layout D & E sets with A squares. Stitch together as shown completing two of each set.



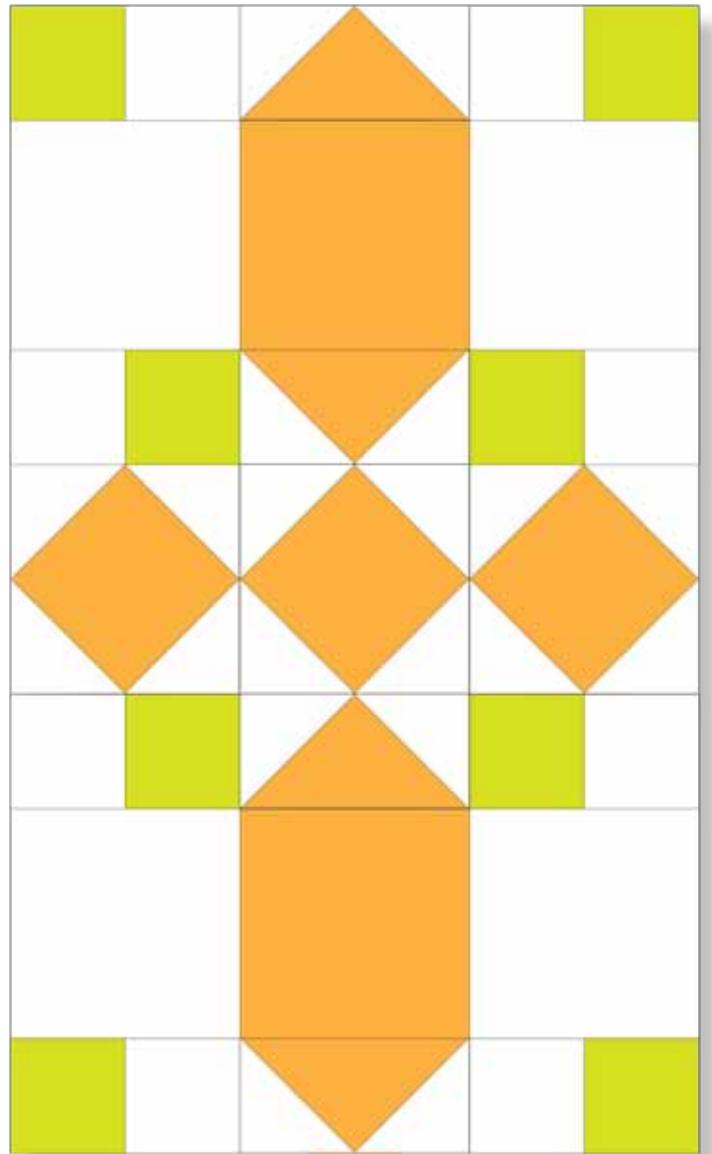
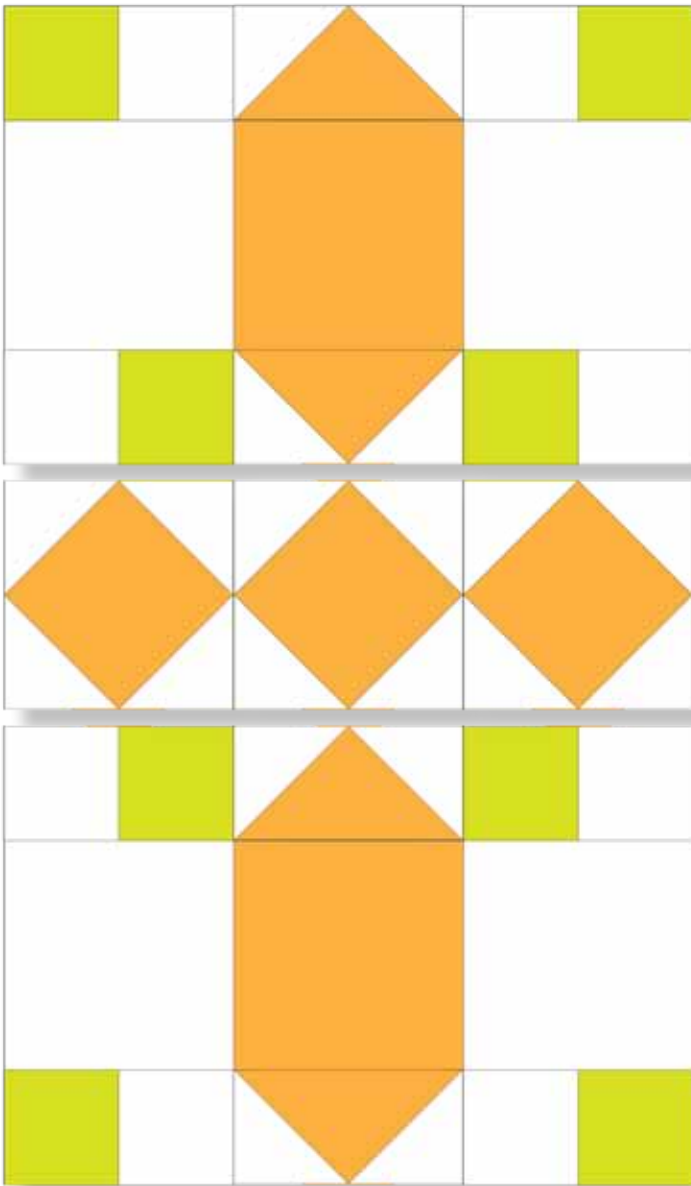
Layout Flying Geese blocks with remaining B squares. Stitch together as shown completing two sets.



Stitch three completed Diamond Blocks together as shown to complete center row.



Arrange completed Flying Geese set between the square sets as shown. Stitch together as shown completing two rows.



Arrange rows as shown to the left and stitch rows together to complete block.
