The Board has had to make another difficult decision. We are saddened to announce that Lincoln Quilters Guild is cancelling the May 11, 2020 guild meeting and the May 12, 2020 workshop.

We were in discussion about this as soon as the CDC and the Lincoln Lancaster County Health department made the announcement on March 16 that "gatherings of 50 people or more be canceled or postponed nationwide for 8 weeks."

As you probably heard, the most recent announcement states that meetings of 10 people or more be cancelled for the next 15 days.

I'm sure that recommendations and restrictions will continue to fluctuate as data is compiled during this pandemic. However, we needed to act in a financially responsible way in order to alert our speaker of the cancellations within the contracted time period.

The Program VPs are working hard to reschedule the wonderful speaker we had lined up.

As we all work together —limiting social contact, staying at home when we are sick, protecting our vulnerable seniors, and doing all that is being recommended by the experts—hopefully we will have done our part to prevent the healthcare system from being overwhelmed, and all of this will be behind us soon.

National Quilting Day 2020 Goes "Virtual"


The International Quilt Museum has announced an alternative to the cancelled National Quilting Day event.
