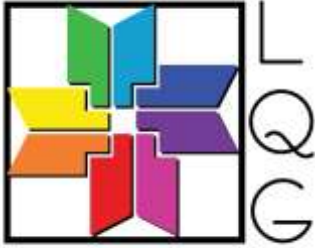

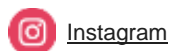
As if March didn't have enough excitement in store, mark your calendars for National Quilting

If you did not get fabric at the November meeting, you can pick it up at Bernina of Lincoln (5500 Old Cheney, Suite 7). Tell them you need your LQG challenge fabric, and they will hook you up! Challenge Rules: Use your imagination, use the fabric, and make the perimeter of your quilt no larger than 72 inches. Challenge quilts will be displayed at the June 12, 2023, 50th anniversary member appreciation event.

Save the date: The 50th anniversary committee is planning a quilt show on Saturday, Oct. 28, 2023. This show will be in a different format from previous multi-day quilt shows put on by the guild. More details will come next year.
