Minutes of the Last Meeting

LINCOLN QUILTERS GUILD MEETING

Monday, May 13, 2019

College View Seventh-Day Adventist Church

President Christina Chapman called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and welcomed everyone. Guests and new members were asked to stand to be recognized and thanked for their attendance.

Old Business

1. President Chapman asked for approval of the April, 2019 LQG meeting minutes. Glenda Johnson moved and Kath Conroy seconded the motion to approve the minutes. All were in favor of approving minutes and none opposed.
2. There were no corrections offered to the February 2019 treasurer's report which will now be remanded for audit.

NEW BUSINESS

President-elect Announcements – Lisa Burham: After the flooding our area experienced this spring, the Board discussed ways that guild members could help with relief efforts. We found information about a couple of women who are collecting quilts and blankets to be delivered to those affected. If you'd like to donate quilts or blankets, please bring them to the August guild meeting and the Board will make sure they get to these women for distribution. In addition, we are looking into the possibility of organizing a Sew Day on a Saturday in

June so folks can work together on quilts for the project. If you're interested, please sign the clipboard on the Bulletin Board table so we can contact you when we have more details.

The guild has been invited to submit quilts for the Nebraska State Quilt Guild's annual quilt show in October. We've been asked to provide 7 large quilts (64 x 64 or larger) and 7 small quilts (anything less than 64 x 64). Since the event is in Kearney, the guild will line up a volunteer to take the quilts to Kearney and a volunteer to return them to Lincoln. If you are interested in submitting a quilt or willing to help with pickup or delivery of the quilts, please contact Christina Chapman at 402-450-1217.

Also, a reminder that the June LQG meeting will be held June 17th at the International Quilt Study Center and Museum (IQSCM). The August meeting will continue to be held at the church on the 2nd Monday of the month.

IQSCM Liaison - Ann Hauder discussed the current exhibits.

SAQA 30th Anniversary: Studio Art Quilt Associates began in 1989 with 50 individuals. Today SAQA includes more than 3,400 members who promote the art quilt through education, exhibitions, professional development, documentation and publications. The exhibition of these 30 small pieces by SAQA members celebrates an important marker of the organization's history.

And these pieces can serve as a source of inspiration for all of us. April 2 - August 4.

Kathy Caraccio - Quilt Series: The artist creates colorful printed paper, cuts the paper into shapes and then arranges the shapes into quilt like designs and patterns that create dynamic visual interactions. These one of a kind paper

collages reflect what we're doing with out quilting and can serve as an inspiration to try a different medium like paper or to turn some of her designs back into an actual quilt. April 24 – September 29.

IQSCM Center Gallery: Alan and Wilma Von Seggern have named the center gallery at the museum for Alan's mom Doris Von Seggern. Doris was a long-time guild member and early cuddle quilt contributor
