Announcements and Committee Reports

International Quilt Museum (IQM) Liaison – Ann Hauder

The newest exhibition at the International Quilt Museum is **Diana Harrison: Traces in Cloth**. Her works are abstract and striking. She starts with black fabric and then works backward, taking the color out. Her process is risky, as she often stitches her three-layered quilt together before applying discharge paste to remove some of the color from various areas. She may then print with white pigment or red dye. In a few pieces, she has even burnt holes with a wood burning tool. Her works will change your perspective on quilts and may even inspire you to take more creative risks. November 1, 2019 – April 26, 2020

There is an opportunity to help the museum and the Lincoln Public Schools. For the second year, LPS 4th graders are visiting the museum and going on tours designed specifically for them. The tours are done by museum staff, docents and volunteers. More help is needed to cover all of the tours. The tours last 45-50 minutes, visiting three galleries.
