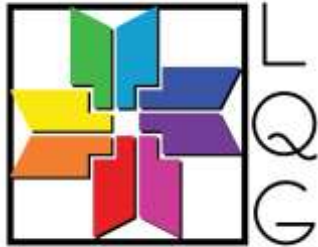

Challenge quilts will be displayed and voted on during our 50th anniversary celebration and salad supper at the International Quilt Museum on June 12.

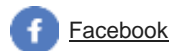
July Class to Feature Freezer Paper, Starch Method for Invisible Machine Applique
