Awards Committee: Lisa Burham

We'd like to award the **LQG Bright Star Award to Chris Taylor.**

This award is given to a member for consistent achievement and continual involvement for the betterment of the Guild over a period of time.

Chris has been involved in quilting since 1997. She has filled many roles in our guild over the years. She was a presenter for our September 2021 meeting and we enjoyed a trunk show of many of her lovely quilts.

Chris is a teacher of quilting – a lifelong skill – and was a role model for the Bryan Alternate School Teen mothers' group, for which our guild donated funds to help purchase sewing machines. One of those moms now has 4 children and she still makes quilts for them every Christmas.

Chris has been an important participant in helping with 4 of our Guild auctions. Her tireless work and countless hours helped to create innovative marketing ideas to boost sales to benefit LQG.

Chris promotes quilts and quilting which is part of our guild's mission to "afford the general public to appreciate quilting and allied arts". She shares her many faceted concepts of quilting that go well beyond needle and thread. Using beads, metal, ribbon and glass, she creates unique stunning visual artwork to share with the quilting world and the viewing public.

She is a supporter of the International Quilt House, a member of SAQA, and a past member of Midwest Fiber Arts Alliance.

She has exhibited quilts at the Mancuso Show in Denver Colorado (where she won the Best use of Color award.) One of her painted quilts was a featured exhibit at the Padukah museum gallery. She's had quilts exhibited at the Lux Center for the Arts, and has regular quilt exhibits at the Burkholder Project in Lincoln. Chris had quilts shown at Lauritzen Gardens in Omaha, the Road to California, and at Quilting in the Tetons. Bryan Medical center has 2 of her quilts on permanent display and she also has a quilt in the permanent collection at the Beatrice, Nebraska library. Many

private collectors own some of Chris' quilts.

She's had quilts at multiple AQS shows, including in Des Moines, Padukah and Arizona (where in 2016 she won first place in Modern Wall Quilts).

Her hard work and talent inspire both quilters and non-quilters and increase the appreciation of quilting for all who enjoy her quilts.
